Dr. KH Wong, Consultant Physician of the Centre for Health Protection of the Department of Health, is a public health clinician specialising in HIV/AIDS. He graduated from the University of Hong Kong in 1988 and received training in internal medicine in Queen Elizabeth Hospital. He began this professional pursuit on HIV/AIDS when joined the Special Preventive Programme (SPP) of the Department of Health in 1993. He became the chief of SPP in 2005. Dr. Wong is one lead HIV physician at the Integrated Treatment Centre (ITC), the largest ambulatory HIV clinical service in Hong Kong. His main research interest is on the application of antiretroviral treatment for clinical and public health good.
