BUSINESS MANAGEMENT

As an introductory text on the application of the Just-in-Time (JIT) concept in business logistics, this book examines different types of waste in business logistics, and discusses ways to enhance efficiency and improve services. It introduces ways to integrate JIT principles with business logistics, and to apply the JIT concept and its supporting management tools to achieve cost and service advantages.

Professor Cheng is currently Chair Professor of Management at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

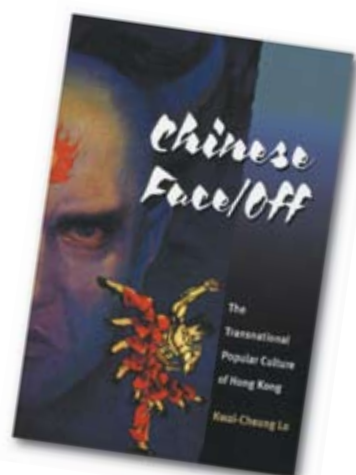

The book offers valuable insights to key issues in the development of business in China from 1500 to the 1990s and sheds new light on the strengths and weaknesses of Chinese business today.

Through the history of rickshaw pullers in Hong Kong and Canton, the book provides a rich portrait of the urban milieu and life in two contrasting yet interrelated cities in South China. Fung Chi-ming explains the dynamics between the rickshaw pullers' participation in collective action and the intervention of the British colonial and Chinese authorities, and traces the pullers' emergence and eclipse as a political force.

Dr Fung works in the Antiquities and Monuments Office, Hong Kong SAR.

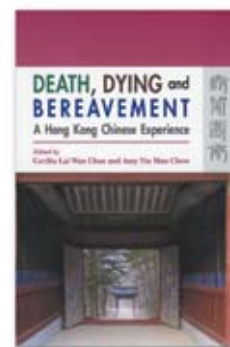
