1. **Harold Hsiao-Wo Lee Professor in Corporate Law (Ref.: RF-2009/2010-229)** (as soon as possible. The academic title of Chair Professor may be offered to a distinguished candidate with exceptional achievements.)
2. **Assistant Professor (Ref.: RF-2009/2010-318)** (from as soon as possible, on a three-year fixed-term basis, with consideration for tenure after satisfactory completion of a second three-year contract)
3. **Research Assistant Professor (Ref.: RF-2009/2010-319)** (from September 10, 2010 or as soon as possible, on a three-year fixed-term basis)

For post (1), applicants should have a distinguished record of research publications in the field of corporate law and private international law/conflict of laws, and has achieved international reputation and eminence. The appointee is expected to play a leadership role in research scholarship on, and the development of, the above areas in the Faculty of Law. Experience in teaching and a track record of research publications in these areas is preferable. **For post (3)**, applicants should have excellent academic qualifications and demonstrated ability and a track record of research in the areas of public law, commercial law or Chinese law. **Review of applications will start from December 1, 2009 until the posts are filled.**
