3. Academic Information:

Semester Dates: Fall semester: early August to mid December. Spring semester: mid January to late May. Summer programs: June/July (4 sessions)

Application Deadlines: Fall: last week of April. Spring: mid November

Arrival Dates: Fall : First week of August. Spring: Second week of January

Orientation Dates: Fall and Spring: Wednesday prior to the first day of classes

Language of Instruction: Mainly Spanish with a wide offering of courses taught in English

Course Structure: The number of contact hours in class is 3 per week. This is equivalent to six academic credits. An international student is expected to attend at least 12 hours a week (or take 24 academic credits).

Exams: UDEM has a period of exams already established which comprehends 3 partial exams and a final, and depending on the professor, they can be both oral and written.
