He has written and edited nine books, including *Worlds in Collision: Terror and the Future of Global Order* (co-edited with Ken Booth) and the 2008 work *Foreign Policy: Theories, Actors, Cases* (co-edited with Steve Smith and Amelia Hadfield). He is an editor of the *European Journal of International Relations* which is the 3rd highest ranking journal in the world for impact in its field. He is a member of the Economic and Social Research Council's college, and has held multiple ESRC research grants for programmes on foreign policy and intervention. The latest research project is in collaboration with the Danish Institute of International Studies entitled 'Liberalisms and World Order'.
