Abstract

The lecture will analyze the most recent changing dynamics of Asia Pacific international relations in the post-cold war and post-financial crisis era. The focus will be on ongoing changes in the relationship among the US, China and Japan. The presentation will aim to answer one central question "Are we going to see an equal distance triangle?". It will provide detailed perspectives from Washington, Tokyo and Beijing, and will illuminate future directions of Asia Pacific international relations.
